# I. God is Independent (Self-Existence/Aseity)

- a. What It Means...
  - i. God Exists Only in Himself

Then Moses said to God, "If I come to the people of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' what shall I say to them?"

God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I AM has sent me to you."

Exodus 3:13-14

## ii. Creation Exists Only in God

"Yet [God] is actually not far from each one of us, for 'In him we live and move and have our being."

Acts 17:27-28

"Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created."

**Revelation 4:11** 

...yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.

1 Corinthians 8:6

[Jesus] is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power.

### b. Why It Matters...

### i. God Cannot Need Anything

Who has first given to me, that I should repay him? Whatever is under the whole heaven is mine.

Job 41:11

The God who made the world and everything in it, being Lord of heaven and earth, does not live in temples made by man, nor is he served by human hands, as though he needed anything, since he himself gives to all mankind life and breath and everything.

Acts 17:24-25

"Not for your sacrifices do I rebuke you; your burnt offerings are continually before me.

I will not accept a bull from your house or goats from your folds.

For every beast of the forest is mine, the cattle on a thousand hills.

I know all the birds of the hills, and all that moves in the field is mine.

Do I eat the flesh of bulls or drink the blood of goats?

### Q: Then why did God create us?


# A: God created us, not because He needed anything, but because He chose to glorify Himself.

In love he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his will, to the praise of his glorious grace, with which he has blessed us in the Beloved.

Ephesians 1:4b-6

Why this is good news for believers: Because God does not need your works nor your relationship, His love for you can never change or ebb and flow, because it is dependent upon Himself who is love and does not change.

### a. What It Means...

#### i. God Has No Beginning or End

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

Genesis 1:1

[Melchizedek] is without father or mother or genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but resembling the Son of God he continues a priest forever.

#### ii. God is Timeless

Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.

## iii. God Sees All Time Simultaneously


For a thousand years in your sight are but as yesterday when it is past, or as a watch in the night.

### b. Why It Matters...

# i. If God seems Delayed in His Promises, He is Not

For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end—it will not lie.

If it seems slow, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay.

#### Habakkuk 2:3

... scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires. They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation." ... But do not overlook this one fact, beloved, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed.
