

I. Principles to keep in mind when studying church history

- 1. There are two extremes to avoid: they got it all right (*therefore we have to go back*); or they got it all wrong (*therefore we can ignore the past & just move on*).
- Christianity is an "earthy", historical religion.
- 3. History tells the story of God's redemption of His people through Jesus Christ.
- 4. History may seem familiar (even repetitive) but it is not cyclical.
