The 5th century: Key men, troubling "isms" and influential councils

Augustine of Hippo	Clarified 2 natures of Christ
Apollinarianism	Founder of the modern papacy
Patrick	Taught that Mary was only the bearer of the human Christ
Nestorianism	Father of expositional preaching
Leo the Great	Missionary to Ireland
Council of Chalcedon	Taught that people were not born dead in sin but simply sick
John Chrystostom	Taught that all people born morally neutral
First Council of Ephesus	Most significant church leader in history next to Paul
Sack of Rome	Taught that Christ had a human body, but not human mind or soul
Pelagianism	Rejected Pelagianism, deposed Nestorius
Jerome	Wrote Latin translation of Bible
Semi-pelagianism	When Rome was sacked
Monophysitism/Eutychianism	Taught that Christ was a hybrid, a somewhat-equal mixture of divine & human
Hypatia	Martyred female philosopher & mathematician
